## Fundy Discovery Aquarium

A life-sized display featuring the magnitude of the Bay of Fundy tides anchors the Fundy Discovery Aquarium. Children and adults alike will make forever memories getting their hands wet and touching our fascinating sea creatures in our two large touch tanks that house intertidal creatures and more! Harbor seal antics will entertain you while underwater viewing of Bay of Fundy fishes will fascinate you. Check out the children's play area, feature films in our theatre, and interactive displays. Stroll our beautiful grounds outdoor play area, enjoy beach access if our enormous tides allow you, and catch our daily feeding presentations. **Ministers Island** is an enchanting place to visit. Lying just off the shore near St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada, this 500-acre island is only a part-time island. You reach it by driving or walking over the seafloor approximately 1 kilometer (1/2 mile). Once there, you are immersed in an experience from the late 19th and early 20th century—the summer estate of Sir William Van Horne, the president and the driving force behind the Canadian Pacific Railway. Time stands still, and you're swept up in an atmosphere that makes you forget all about your everyday life and the here-and-now. Admission required.
